2 performance evenings of songs by Lola Kiepja

Lola Kiepja (d. 1966 in Tierra del Fuego) was a Selk'nam shaman and singer. She was known as 'the last Ona' or 'the last Selk'nam.' She was one of the last members of the Selk'nam (Ona) culture to possess direct knowledge of the traditions, songs, and art of this ancient Tierra del Fuego culture.

In 1964, the French ethnologist Anne Chapman traveled to Tierra del Fuego and documented Lola Kiepja's Selk'nam traditions and songs. Chapman recorded Lola Kiepja's songs with a tape recorder, and some of these recordings were produced and released on two albums by the Museum of Man in Paris.
